

#### ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION-ASK, DON'T TELL!

## Letters of Recommendations:

ASK your teachers and mentors if they would be willing to write a letter on your behalf BEFORE listing their names as references or recommenders.



#### ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION - SHARE INFO!

Have a copy of your résumé in hand when asking for a recommendation from someone.

Include instructions on how to submit the recommendation.



#### WHO TO ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION ?????

**Do** – ask a teacher who can speak to your growth as a student, your character with your peers, your contribution to the learning environment.

**Do** – ask an adviser for an organization or club who can speak to your work ethic or consistent dedication to projects or volunteerism.

**Do** – a member of the clergy, youth ministry director, coach, or club or community leader who has seen you in action or when you have struggled, yet dealt well with adversity.

#### WHO TO ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION ?????

Don't – ask for a rec letter from a teacher whose class you slept through and never completed homework in...

**Don't** – use <u>only</u> recommenders outside of the school environment because that sends a message too...

**Don't** – list a person's name and email as a recommender before asking them if they would write for you, and then ask them why they haven't completed your rec letter...

#### WHO TO ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION ?????

Don't – worry if you had a bumpy high school career and you just figured it all out with a massive turnaround and burst of maturity. Meet with that person who has witnessed your growth and talk through your journey.

Some of my **VERY BEST** rec letters have been for students who struggled in high school to figure it out or to get going!

Don't be so hard on yourself! Come talk!



#### ASK FOR A RECOMMENDATION - STRATEGIZE!

Select a recommender who can speak to your performance or growth over time.

Do not wait until the last minute.

Give the recommender at least 3 weeks to write your letter.

Follow up on deadlines for submission!



#### LET'S TALK MONEY

The largest lump sums of scholarship money is awarded directly from the university.

Schools have general scholarship applications, departmental applications, special programs applications, LuckyDay, and endowed scholarship applications.



#### WHAT SHOULD I BE DOING NOW?

Common App, Special Program Applications, Scholarships A, and Admissions Essays:

Don't put off your essays until your application deadline is looming. Research essay questions for the schools to which you plan to apply.

Ask for help proofreading and editing.



#### WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM?

Automatic Scholarships - Awarded by universities usually on a matrix chart Endowed Scholarships - Special applications with universities

Pell Grants Federal Money (FAFSA)

State Aid Money (MTAG/MESG)

Micro-scholarships - Smaller scholarships but usually only a one-time offer Outside Sources (private scholarships, companies, civic organizations and businesses, parent's employers)


Every college has specific deadlines for Admissions, Early Entry Programs, Early Action or Early Decision, Scholarship Applications, Special Programs, Housing, Immunization Form, Deposits, etc.



#### HAVE YOU DONE THIS?









Apply to the University or College and pay the application fee

Complete an OLA transcript request form and sign it

Send your ACT/SAT scores from your account directly to the university

Complete the Scholarship Applications, Complete FAFSA and Mississippi State Aid Application

#### FEDERAL STUDENT AID



Some states and MOST colleges use information from the FAFSA form to determine your eligibility for their grants, scholarships, and loans.

**MUST BE FILED EVERY YEAR!** 



#### MISSISSIPPI STUDENT AID



MTAG (MS Tuition Assistance Grant) (MS colleges only) 15 ACT and 2.5 GPA

\$500 per year (Freshman and Sophomore) \$1000.00 per year (Junior and Senior)

MESG (MS Eminent Scholars Grant)
(MS colleges only) 29 ACT Superscore and up with 3.5 GPA+

\$2500.00 per year (Freshman thru Senior Years)

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#### HELP GRANT



#### INITIAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT:

- HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR, LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR ONE YEAR PRIOR TO APPLICATION.
- HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) OF 2.5 ON A 4.0 SCALE.
- SCORE A MINIMUM OF 20 ON THE NATIONAL ACT. SUPERSCORES ARE ACCEPTED.
- COMPLETE A SPECIFIC HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM.
- MEET INCOME LIMITATIONS:
- DEMONSTRATE NEED BY COMPLETING (FAFSA) AND QUALIFYING FOR A MAXIMUM OR PARTIAL FEDERAL PELL GRANT.
